Minimum 4 Bikers • Treo Lodge has 14 beds

Treo Lodge is a great base for a multi-day bike outing:

- Through the Blue Mountains to the John Day River
- Through the rolling hills to Condon
- Through the farm lands to Heppner and Lone

Mileage per day can be changed to accommodate each group's ability.

Treo will provide:

- The support team during your stay
- Food service (dinner, breakfast, lunch, beverages)
- Lodging
- Transportation during your stay



Schedule for two days two nights

Arrive at the Treo Lodge at 1pm

- Move in to lodge
- Bike Ride 2pm - 5pm afternoon ride (20 miles) through Range Country - Hardman to Ruggs to Treo Headquarters
- Return drive to Treo Lodge on the back roads through cattle country
- Bikes will be hauled



Dinner at 7pm (family style dinner)

Your Choice of Prime Rib with baked potato, New York Steak with homemade pasta and brandy sauce, or Chicken Breast with homemade pasta and brandy sauce, all served with vegetable, homemade rolls and dessert



Breakfast at 7:30am (family style breakfast)

Your Choice of Pancakes or Biscuits and Gravy, served with bacon, eggs, and fried potatoes

Bike Ride starting at 8:30am (50 miles) through the Blue Mountains

- Hardman through the Blue Mountains to the John Day River, then to Kimberly, to Monument
- Treo will have staff to serve drinks, lunch, and help with repairs as needed
- The return drive to the Treo Lodge will be through the Blue Mountains from Monument to Hardman
- Bikes will be hauled back



Dinner at 7pm (family style dinner)

Your Choice of Prime Rib with baked potato, New York Steak with homemade pasta and brandy sauce, or Chicken Breast with homemade pasta and brandy sauce, all served with vegetable, homemade rolls and dessert

Breakfast at 7:30am (family style breakfast)

Bike Ride starting at 8:30am (50 miles) Beautiful Creek ride and back through Wheat Country

- Hardman to Ruggs to Lone, then Gooseberry Rd to Treo Headquarters
- Vehicles will be moved from Treo Lodge to Treo Headquarters
